North Star Sensors, LLC is committed to sourcing components and materials from companies that share our values regarding respect for human rights, integrity, and environmental responsibility.

North Star Sensors, LLC is committed to following the OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas, as well as the applicable requirements of Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act, which aims to prevent the use of minerals that directly or indirectly finance, or benefit armed groups in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or in adjoining countries.

Applicable suppliers to North Star Sensors, LLC will be required to have a policy to reasonably assure that the tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold (“Conflict Minerals”) in the materials they manufacture are not from sources described above. Each applicable supplier shall exercise due diligence on the source and supply chain of the Conflict Minerals that it purchases and make its due diligence measures available to North Star Sensors, LLC upon request.
